After the delivery of the judgment, Mr. Tapan Mukherjee, learned Additional Government Pleader, prays for stay of the operation of the order.

Mr. L.K. Gupta, learned senior counsel, appearing for the petitioners, opposed this prayer.

However, Mr. Mukherjee and Mr. Jaharlal De, learned advocates appearing for the State and Mr. Bari, the learned Advocate appearing for the Commission, have assured this Court that after the relevant provisions of the Act have been declared ultra vires the Constitution, the

Commission shall not recommend any name till any order is obtained from the Appellate Court and shall not insist upon the appointment of the candidates recommended by the Commission to different posts in Madrasahs. On such assurance being given by the learned Advocates for the State and the

Commission, the operation of the judgment and order is stayed for a period of two weeks from date.
